In particular, on the basis of this organization, PISA (The program for international student assessment) - the international program for the assessment of student literacy was developed in order to develop general secondary education, which is the main link of the education system. The reason why the economic organization turns to the education sector is that the personnel for any field is first of all grown up in schools and ordinary classrooms. In this sense, the OESD organization aimed to create a ranking of how much money the member states spend on the education system and how effective they are. Later, other countries became more interested in this research, and today the number of member countries of the organization is increasing.

A key consideration in selecting texts for the PIRLS assessment program is to provide several text types based on intended reading goals. In doing so, the main goal is to create an environment similar to classroom and classroom learning for students. The student is an active participant in this process, observing the text and consciously choosing effective reading strategies. Each type of text follows typical patterns and rules to help the student interpret the text. Any text can have different forms. These include traditional books, magazines, documents and newspapers, as well as written texts in digital form.

This environment extends beyond the classroom as students discuss information and ideas from their studies with their family members and peers. Currently, PIRLS defines reading literacy as the ability to understand and use forms of written language that are required by society and valued by humans, as well as the ability to make meaning from texts in various forms.

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
